SUBJECT: Child Care and JOBS Supportive Services - Claiming

This is to <u>remind</u> districts of the importance of using the proper payment type codes when authorizing training-related child care and JOBS supportive services. The use of these payment type codes was outlined in 90 ADM-27. Districts should already be following the proper procedures.

Training-related child care and JOBS supportive services cannot be authorized with ADC monies. The federal government has informed the Department that any ADC monies used to authorize training-related child care or JOBS supportive services will be considered a quality control error. For ADC cases, training-related child care must be authorized as IV-A child care (non-ADC) and JOBS supportive services as IV-F JOBS. For HR cases, these allowances must be authorized with HR monies.

To insure that training-related child care and JOBS supportive services are correctly claimed, the proper payment type codes must be used on the DSS-3209.
